Here's how volunteers can make a difference in Bellevue:

- Volunteer to be a team leader or participant by helping pick up trash along the streets, curbs, sidewalks, alleys and in our parks.
- Trash owners can help haul collected trash. Please let us know in advance if you are willing to be a “hauler”.
- Join your neighbors to clean out yards and flowerbeds, wash windows, paint, and spruce up the area around your property.
